

It also wasn't as inclusive as I had hoped it would be, showing a very diverse neighborhood. I was very disappointed, especially because I have other books by Lisa Bullard that I like very much.

I used this book in a lesson for my second graders about learning about communities and their own communities. It was a great book to discuss and spark dialogue about similarities and differences in communities, what types of things we see in a community, and what we do in communities. It was perfect!
